

INTERLIBRARY LOAN

Library patrons to whom the Hussey-Mayfield Memorial Public Library has issued a borrower's card may use the Interlibrary Loan service except those patrons:

- 1. Who have outstanding fines and fees totaling \$10.00 or more and/or
- 2. Who have overdue Library materials and/or
- 3. Who are Public Library Access Card [PLAC] holders¹

Materials borrowed for Hussey-Mayfield patrons through interlibrary loan from another Library outside of the Evergreen consortium must be returned to the Hussey-Mayfield Library by the due date and may not be renewed.

Library patrons with overdue interlibrary loan items will be fined at the current rate of the lending library for each day each item is overdue. Weekends and holidays shall be included in the computation of the overdue fee. In addition, failure to return materials on time or to pick up items ordered from another Library might result in the suspension of interlibrary loan services for the delinquent patron.

If the lending library charges Hussey-Mayfield for the loan of materials, those charges will be passed along to the patron. The Library patron is given the option of specifying a maximum charge before the item is requested. If the patron declines to pay any charges and the item is not available without charge, the request will not be filled.

The timely return of interlibrary loan materials in good repair is essential for continued access to this service.
