HMMPL is a growing, thriving library serving Central Indiana residents who live in Eagle, Union and Worth townships. The Library provides services to more than 19,000 cardholders at every stage of life, and currently has the second highest circulation rate per capita in the state.



PROVIDING RESOURCES

Patrons of HMMPL have access to over **7 million** items through the Evergreen Indiana Library Consortium. In addition, the Library boasts a variety of **special collections**, including Wi-Fi hotspots, book club kits, book packs for children, and **museum passes**. Cardholders also have access to a wide-range of **digital resources** and **streaming media**, including access to Consumer Reports Online, The Wall Street Journal Online, Hoopla, Tutor.com, and many more.

SCHOOL RESOURCES

HMMPL works with teachers and media specialists at both Zionsville and Lebanon schools to provide additional resources for learning. Book club sets and access to a variety of digital resources help increase the range and accessibility of educational materials for teachers.

Digital library cards are provided for each student, which provide full access to the entire HMMPL digital library collection.

MOBILE OUTREACH

HMMPL offers a multitude of services that reach beyond the Library's walls. The Bookmobile visits locations within Eagle, Union and Worth townships. Homebound delivery and Library Day visits to independent-living and assisted-living facilities help individuals access information when in-person visits are not possible.

BUILDING EXCITEMENT

The community is quickly outgrowing the Library's current building located at 250 N. 5th St. in Zionsville, Indiana. More people now sign up to take part in programs than space allows. Record-setting circulation in June 2022 of more than 75,000 items highlights the community's increasing demand for library services.



To meet the growing needs, a **new, 23,000 square-foot branch**, located at 6310 E. Albert S. White Blvd. in Whitestown is currently under construction, and is scheduled to be completed in late summer 2023.



The new branch will complement the current location with large green spaces, exterior patios and porches, and a large community meeting room which will be available for use both during and outside of regular business hours.

The branch will also feature a larger, fully equipped MakerStudio, a sound booth, study rooms and programming spaces.

LIBRARY FAQS

Q: How can I get a Library card?

A: If you live in Eagle, Union or Worth Township, simply complete the online application on our website and then wait for an email that says your card is ready for you to pick up. Or, come to the Library and one of our friendly staff can create your new account.

Q: Can Perry Township residents get a Library card?

A: Yes! HMMPL currently has a contract with the Town of Zionsville in which the town will pay for one card per Perry Township household. Perry Township residents may bring their current ID to the Library to register for a card.

Q: When will the new Library branch open?

A: Construction is scheduled to be completed by late summer 2023, with plans to open soon after.

Q: Who can use the new Library branch?

A: All cardholders and visitors will have access to both locations. Each location will have different features and benefits. We expect that our cardholders will enjoy different aspects about each location and will want to use both branches.
