Double Your Investment in Literacy for Our Community



Hussey-Mayfield Memorial Public Library has been chosen as a recipient of a **Community Foundation of Boone County (CFBC) Education & Development of Literacy matching grant**. All donations given to HMMPL through Oct. 15 will be matched dollar-for-dollar by CFBC, up to \$20,000.

Funds raised throughout the matching grant period will be used

for the Library's **Pathway to Literacy** initiative at the Whitestown Branch currently under construction at 3601 S. Albert S. White Drive.

Projects to be funded include a StoryWalk® along the current trail through the wooded area behind the new branch, a collection of nature and read-a-long books, and Pea Pod Packs with 10 board books prepackaged into a tote.

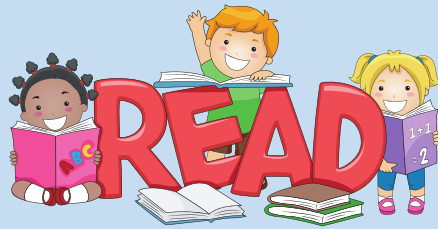
