MAKERSTUDIO — \$75,000

Help us fill the new MakerStudio with tools and technology to help creativity flourish! A laminator, laser cutter, sewing and embroidery machines, robotics education tools and much more are planned for this innovative area.



QUIET READING ROOM — \$50,000

Adults looking for a place to focus will enjoy our welcoming Quiet Reading Room. Visitors can settle into a comfy chair in front of a dual-sided gas fireplace and enjoy views of nature or make a selection from our Whitestown History Collection.



CHILDREN'S DEPARTMENT — \$50,000

Designed to spark creativity, this area will feature an oversized imagination tree at its center, open exploring space and an enclosed playroom. Large rear windows with adjacent doors lead to an outdoor patio and green space designed for families.



SOUND BOOTH — \$25,000

The Library's recording studio offers the perfect setting for activities requiring a soundproof space, including practicing a musical instrument, creating podcasts, editing video and music, and more.



TEEN AREA — \$25,000

This room is specifically designed to make teens feel valued and welcome at the Library. The Teen Area, for those 12 - 18, will encourage engagement, learning and participation.

A grassy lawn just outside the children's reading area will be developed for outdoor learning and fun. Unique opportunities abound for this green space and can be tailored to meet donation budgets.
