## Communicate & Collaborate

- Continually seek, evaluate, and implement strategies that connect people to services.
  - Use of the Library's website will increase.
  - People will say they are aware of Library programs, resources, and services of value to them.
- Design and implement effective communication methods that help keep people informed about their community and available services within and beyond the Library.
  - The Library will increase the number of languages in which marketing and communication materials are available.
  - Program enrollment and attendance will increase.
  - People will indicate they know how to locate and are aware of community information.
  - Teen program attendance will increase.
- Develop strategies to gather, evaluate, and incorporate feedback and input from Library users and the community.
  - The Library will provide at least 3 opportunities a year for community input.
  - People will indicate they are very satisfied with Library events.



## Foster Community Connections

- Provide safe and inclusive spaces for people to share, connect, and engage together in. Support the rights of every individual to read, seek information, and speak freely as guaranteed by the First Amendment.
  - People will indicate they feel more connected and engaged with their community.
  - Increase active engagement on the Library's social media presence.
- Expand the Library's collaboration with community organizations to increase access to resources.
  - The number of outreach interactions with community organizations will increase.
  - The number of Library volunteers will increase.
- Provide support and resources for local business owners and entrepreneurs.
  - Increase the number of business owners and entrepreneurs utilizing Library resources and services.
  - Increase in businesses and other local organizations sharing about Library resources and services.



# Cultivate an Open & Welcoming Energy

- We ensure our spaces, services, resources, and programs are representative of diverse cultures and perspectives, intentionally inclusive, and accessible to everyone.
  - People will say they feel represented in Library spaces, collections, events, etc.
  - People will indicate that displays, collections, and events represent a variety of people, perspectives, and cultures.
- Provide physical and online spaces that are comfortable, accessible, and meet a variety of needs.
  - Number of visits to the Library spaces will increase.
  - Visits and usage of the Library's website will increase.
  - People will indicate they perceive the Library as a safe space.
  - People will say the Library spaces are easy to navigate and accessible.

## Enhance Services to Meet Emerging Needs

- Continue to seek creative and flexible ways to serve the community.
  - People will indicate they see the Library as a central space to gather outside of home, school, or work.
- Create dynamic spaces and services that meet needs based on community input, outreach efforts to the community, and intentional strategy.
  - Use of Library services and resources will increase.
  - Engagement with people in the community who are underrepresented in the Library will increase.
  - The number of new Library cards issued will increase.
  - The number of active Library cardholders will increase.
- Strategize and identify new sources for funding for Library resources and services for the community.
  - Donations from local organizations will increase.
  - Number of contacts to local organizations for Library fundraising will increase.
